

COUNTRY PIECEMAKERS' FAQs

- How do I donate pillow cases?
 1. Donation pillowcases (using your own fabrics or kits provided at meetings) can be brought to any meeting and given to the Pillow Case coordinator.
 2. Instructions for making pillow cases are on the website, under Guild News/ Community Projects.
 3. If you have fabric to donate for pillow cases, fabric can be given to Pillow Case Coordinator at any Guild meetings.
 4. The Pillow Case Coordinator will bring pillow case kits to each meeting.
 5. The Guild will have a Pillow Case Day once a year, devoted to making pillow cases
- How do I donate fabric for community projects?
 1. Typically, fabric will be collected for each project as needed.
 2. Fabric that is donated in quantity will be made available to members at meetings, usually as a fund-raise (raffle, sale by piece, etc.)
- What are the guidelines for making donation quilts for the NICU and Nursing Home?
 1. Guidelines for donation quilts are provided on the website under Guild News/Community Projects
- How do I get my Donation Quilts quilted?
 1. Quilts for NICU and Nursing Home can be taken to one of our member long-arm quilters. Guild members will pay \$10/quilt directly to the long-armed. The Guild provides batting for these quilts.
 2. Long-arm quilting for larger donation quilts, such as Veterans Quilts, will also be done by our member long-arm quilters; however, the cost will be covered by the Guild.
- Do I have to pay for classes that are scheduled at Guild Meetings?
 1. Members do not normally have to pay for classes that are part of Guild programming.
 2. In the case of specialty guest instructors, a fee may be required from members to help cover the cost.
 3. If supplies or kits are required for the class, each member will bring or pay for her own supplies or kits. The supply list will be provided before the class.
- Do members get paid for teaching classes at Guild meetings?
 1. Members are encouraged to share skills by teaching classes. The Guild does not pay members for teaching.
- What are our community project and fundraising activities?
 1. Our fundraising activities at our meetings include raffles, silent auctions, sale of lovingly owned items
 2. Our community projects include donation of pillow cases and donation of quilts for NICUs, Nursing Homes and Veterans.
 3. All proceeds from our fundraisers are used for our donation projects.
